Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

SON OF A BIRCH tracked two wide and between horses, tipped to take aim from the four path entering the lane, forged an advantage before changing leads at the three sixteenths pole, lugged outwardly leaving the furlong grounds, drifted inwardly while dueling with an inner bidder in the late stages, bumped that foe at the wire and held. DEMOLITION DUKE settled off of the pace in the two path, split foes at the furlong grounds to take aim inside of the new leader, bid and dueled through the final sixteenth, but was bumped by his outer counterpart at the wire and missed. CALIBRACHOA KID pressed three wide, but drifted to the six path entering the lane, yet sustained a chase to fend off inner rivals for show. MESA SPIRIT stalked along the inside, checked passing the three furlong pole, tipped to the five path entering the lane, chased between horses thereafter but was denied reaching show. COACHES

MEETING bumped with an outer rival at the start, saved ground well back, shifted to the three path in upper stretch and stayed on mildly. PREMIUM prompted two wide, vied in the three path entering the lane, but was headed by an outer bidder at the three sixteenths pole and faded. WESTERN COMMAND set a pressured pace along the inside, got headed by an outer bidder entering the lane and folded through the final furlong. GUILTY AFFAIR bumped an inner rival at the start, raced off of the pace four wide, floated to the seven path in upper stretch and failed to factor. HALMSTAD bumped with an inner rival then an outer foe at the start, pursued from midpack four wide and gave way between horses. C'EST MAGNIFIQUE made little impact from the four path. STARTONAHIGHNOTE was bumped between horses at the start, raced off of the pace in the three path and among foes, then weakened. THE FEATURE trailed in the four to five path before swinging to the nine path entering the lane, and got outrun.
